 - b. Living in relationship with rest-of-nature leading to mutual prosperity

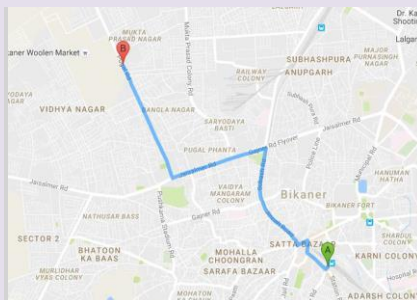
